As per memorandum of settlement 1969 that the pay and allowances of Cantonment Board employee be broadly equated with state Govt at District level. Shri Pradeep Kumar Prusty incumbent of the post of Compounder was appointed in this Board w.e.f. 02.09.2002 in the pay scale of 4500-125-700 (as per 5th pay commission) the pay scale has been revised in pay band 5200-20200 and GP 2800 as per 6th pay Commission. (i) Repair and renovation of Cantt. fund Buildings :- Total 04 technical bids were received on 10.06.2016 through CPP Portal in response to the said tender. Sri Sanjay Yadav (Elected member ward no 01) and the tender committee members have examined the technical bid documents submitted by the bidders and found that three bidders qualify in the technical evaluation. The financial bid has been opened in the presence of Sri Sanjay Yadav (Elected member ward no 01) and tendering committee on 14.06.2016 at 1300 hrs in this office.

Sri Sanjay Yadav (Elected member ward no 01) and the tender committee members have examined the technical bid documents submitted by the bidders and found that one bidder (Shri Upendra Sharma, Mathura) has not attached the sufficient experience certificate alongwith his documents. As the participation is less than three & due to non sufficient experience certificate by the one bidder, therefore Sri Sanjay Yadav (Elected member ward no 01) and the tender committee decided that the said tender may be re-published.

However, the applicant vide his letter dated 12.05.2016 and requested to relax bye-laws No. 07 as structurally he is unable to maintain 20 feet distance between toilet and kitchen . As per bye-laws No. 07, in cases where distance of 20 feet between kitchen and latrine is not possible, every application shall be considered on merits by the Board.

A proposal for construction of guest house building situated at Yodha Marg, Mathura Cantt. was forwarded to DG, DE through PD.DE. CC. Lucknow Cantt. on 25.11.2013. The said proposal has returned by PD.DE on 03.05.2016 and intimate that due to allotment of limited funds by Central Govt. in DE Budget head “ Grants for creation of Capital Assets”, the proposal of Cantonment Board, Mathura seeking grant-in-aid for construction of guest house building at Yodha Marg, Mathura Cantt. could not be forwarded to Min. of Defence for sanction in the previous financial year. The total amount demanded for this proposal is Rs. 2.20 crore. As construction of guest house is the last priority of works in capital assets and due to shortage of funds the project for construction of guest house may not be got cleared.

Cantt. Board Mathura does not have any source of revenue generation. Therefore the Board may consider to may construct marriage garden cum guest house of this land in place of guest house as resolved vide above referred CBR. For preparing design / drawing and estimates for construction of marriage garden cum guest house, a reputed architect will be hired and likely expenditure would be Rs. 1.50 lac (Approx).
